

# INTERDISCIPLINARY STUDIES (ITDS)

## **ITDS-200H Honors Leadership 2 Credits**

This course serves as an introduction to leadership theory and leadership praxis for students in the Honors Program. Special attention will be given to (1) developing a leadership perspective; (2) identifying events in one's own life that shape the influence one has over self and others; and (3) how the nature and presence of a leader impacts organizations.

## **ITDS-305H Christian Leadership/Multifaith World 3 Credits**

The Christian Leadership in a Multifaith World Curriculum explores the Christian foundation for interfaith engagement, builds students' religious literacy, and equips students to lead bridge-building activities in their communities. Students will design a bridge-building project that puts their education into action.

## **ITDS-310H Introduction to Leadership Theory 3 Credits**
